

Alberta High School Diploma

The Alberta High School Diploma is awarded to students meeting the requirements outlined below:

To earn an Alberta High School Diploma, a student must earn a minimum of 100 credits. Within these 100 credits, the following three categories must be included:

1. Complete and meet the standards in:
 - English 30-1 or 30-2
 - Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2
 - A 20 level Math: Mathematics 20-1, 20-2 or 20-3
 - A 20 level Science: Biology 20, Chemistry 20, Physics 30 or Science 24
 - Physical Education 10 (3 credits)
 - Career and Life Management (CALM) 20 (3 credits)
2. Achieve, at minimum, 10 credits in one of the following: (Note: locally developed courses are excluded from this category)
 - Career and Technology Studies courses such as Fitness and Nutrition
 - Sports Medicine, Construction, New Media, Foods, Information Programming or Computer Programming
 - Fine Arts courses such as Band, Drama or Art
 - A second language (such as French or Spanish)
 - Physical Education
 - French Language Arts
3. Achieve, at minimum, 10 credits in any 30 level course (including locally developed courses)

In addition to the Alberta Education requirements listed above St. Luke's students must take a Religion course for each year enrolled.
